

Magma Coral Bells



Because of their low, mounding habit, they are often used as edging along paths or in containers. Try cutting a few of the tall flower scapes for fresh bouquets.

Heuchera 'Magma' PP29116

- **Use:** Heucheras are easy perennials to grow and fit nicely in the front of any border, rock garden, or container. Billowing red flowers in summer float above on tall scapes. As the summer heat sets in, this highly heat and humidity tolerant plant flourishes in border or container, its leaves becoming a bit less brilliant, only to rebound into glory with shades of deep red and burgundy in autumn.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun (morning sun/afternoon shade is best)-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Will tolerate full sun with sufficient water. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Fast growth to 20-24" tall, 20" in bloom overall, by 30-36" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Large, deep pink leaves turn mahogany red as the season progresses.
- **Flower:** Pink-red flowers emerge during the summer on very long red stems. Delightful! Use as a cut flower.
