Heuchera x 'Paprika'

- <u>Use:</u> Spicy, hot! Coral cherry paprika colored foliage adds bold flair. Foliage is lightly veiled in silver. Color will lighten to peach tones in summer's heat and deepen again in fall.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Part sun-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- <u>Growth</u>: Fast growth to 8 "tall, 24" in bloom overall, by 12-18" wide.
- *Hardiness:* Zone 4-9; Perennial
- Foliage: Semi-evergreen. Large, warm, glowing cherry-coral foliage could stop a Mack truck. A spicy favorite of our evaluation team!
- *Flower:* White flowers hover above the blazing leaves.
