- <u>Use:</u> Excellent in containers or the shade border. It lights up the shade garden year-round. This free-flowering cultivar produces a plethora of large, deep rose-pink flowers on 14 inch scapes beginning in late spring.
 - **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Best when planted under other small trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- <u>Growth</u>: Fast growth to 8-10" tall, 24" in bloom overall, by 12-14" wide. Frequent division helps to maintain vigor.
- Hardiness: Zone 4a-9b; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Mirror-bright silver-white foliage with green veins is truly showy. Colors intensify in the fall with colder nights.
- <u>Flower:</u> Delicate, free-flowering cultivar with lots of large, deep rose-pink flowers on 14 inch scapes beginning in late spring.
