

# Pink Panther Heuchera



A garden designer's favorite, Coral Bells' superior mounded form and striking evergreen leaves makes it ideal for containers and edging, or for neat and tidy designs.



## *Heuchera 'Pink Panther'*

- **Use:** If you love pink, you'll love the leaf color of 'Pink Panther.' In spring, semi-glossy leaves emerge metallic pink, maturing to a dark berry pink with darker veins as the season progresses. Plant in an area with filtered light or in shade to protect the lighter coloration and to bring out the best hue. Dark rose calyxes hold light pink flowers on dark stems. This is perfect as an accent in combination containers, or to bring a splash of color to your shade garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Thrives in dry shade once established. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Clumping foliage 10-12 in. tall, 16-20 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Features semi-glossy leaves that emerge metallic pink and mature to a dark berry pink with darker veining as the season progresses. Plant in filtered light or shade in order to protect the lighter coloration and bring out the best hue.
- **Flower:** Tall airy spikes of pink flowers in summer.
