

Plum Power Heuchera



This plant is a *Heuchera villosa* hybrid. The *H. villosa* species is a robust, late blooming type that exhibits an increased tolerance of high heat and humidity over other species. *H. villosa* is native to the southeastern United States.



Heuchera villosa 'Plum Power'

- **Use:** suitable for use in containers on your terrace or patio, in perennial borders or in mixed containers. Vigorous variety which can handle both extreme heat and extreme cold. 'Plum Power' is resistant to diseases and is not fussy about soil type.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Reaches a height of 14" and a width of 20"
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4b-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Beautiful, striking, dark leaf markings. Its foliage color changes throughout the year. From burgundy red to classy purple-pink with a touch of silver. The size of its leaves can be up to 8" wide and 14" long.
- **Flower:** Tall dark pink, airy spikes of flowers in summer and again in fall.
