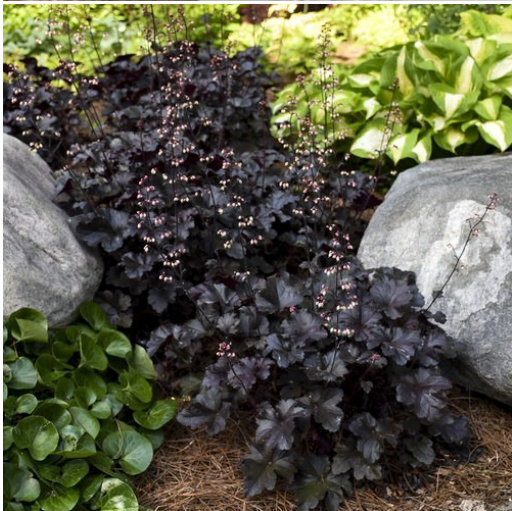


Primo Black Pearl Coral Bells



Because of their low, mounding habit, they are often used as edging along paths or in containers. Try cutting a few of the tall flower scapes for fresh bouquets.

Heuchera 'Primo Black Pearl'

- **Use:** Coral Bells are a versatile perennial. Excellent heat and humidity tolerance, is a terrific choice for adding a touch of color towards the front of a border. Pair with chartreuse foliage for a showstopping scene.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun– part shade. More sun tolerant than other coral bells. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Fast growth to 8-10 “tall, 18-20” wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4a-9b; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. A stunning black foliage plant for both shade and sun! Forms an incredibly dense habit of shiny, jet black leaves with scalloped, ruffled edges and rosy purple undersides.
- **Flower:** Dainty pink flowers are held aloft on airy stems May through July.
