- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Clumping foliage 12 in. tall, 24 in. wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 4a-9b; Perennial
- *Foliage:* Semi-evergreen. Forms a dense habit of large, bright rosy purple leaves with prominent deep charcoal gray veining
- Flower: Upright, dark burgundy stems hold rosy pink flowers.
