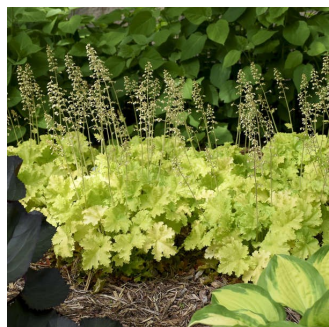


Twist of Lime Heuchera



Heuchera 'Twist of Lime' PP30618

- **Use:** Get ready for a wild looking Heuchera that's perfect for brightening up your shade garden! Incredibly wavy, chartreuse yellow leaves beg to be noticed, and is perhaps one of our brightest yellow Heucheras. Ruffling becomes less pronounced as the foliage matures. For best yellow color, site in dappled shade or morning sun. Coral bells are easy to grow and blend easily with most other perennials in the landscape. Because of their low, mounding habit, they are often used as edging along paths or in containers. Native to North America.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Morning sun and afternoon shade. Best when planted under other trees (not close to oak as they are shallow rooted) , but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Moderate growing; foliage reaches 8-10" tall, 12-16" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Features bright lime green foliage.
- **Flower:** Cream flowers appear in early summer. Try cutting a few of the tall flower scapes for fresh bouquets.
