

Alabama Sunrise Foamy Bells



Heucherella 'Alabama Sunrise'

- **Use:** The deeply cut foliage of 'Alabama Sunrise' changes color with the seasons. Bright gold, red-veined leaves become greener but hold that brilliant red flash; in fall, the older leaves develop coral tones. Humidity tolerant, too.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Fast growth to 10 "tall, 24" in bloom overall, by 12-18" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Lovely leaves of yellow to lime with a large red centre and a strong white veil overall.
- **Flower:** White, bell-shaped blooms rise above height given: up to 16" in the summer.
