

Art Tropico Foamy Bells

- **Use:** Now here's a beautiful accent for the partly to fully shaded border or container: a brilliantly variegated perennial with large, maple-leaf-like foliage of golden with generous maroon markings.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun (afternoon shade preferred)-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Fast growth to 10" tall, 16" in bloom overall, by 15" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Emerges with bright yellow leaves with thin red markings. It adds a vivid splash of tropical color to the border or containers. Slightly trailing mounds are the perfect for lining beds or interplanting with taller perennials.
- **Flower:** Small white blooms dangle above the foliage in late spring and early summer.

Because of their low, mounding habit, they are often used as edging along paths or in containers. Try cutting a few of the tall flower scapes for fresh bouquets.
