Heuchera x 'Cracked Ice'

- **Use:** You don't have to watch your step around this icy beauty. Unusual, frosted blue and green tones are punctuated with dramatic veining in summer. Compact, mounding habit. Vigorous, easy to grow and healthy, with a natural resistance to rust. Cold, heat and humidity tolerant. Bred by Terra Nova Nurseries and introduced by Blooms of Bressingham.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Fast growth to 12-15 "tall, 18" in bloom overall, by 12-18" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. In early spring and fall, leaves get a lovely silvery pink overlay. The fantastic deeply cut foliage, changing color and veining add textural pizzazz to any container or landscape.
- **Flower:** White flowers hover above the blazing leaves.
