

Hot Buttered Rum Foamy Bells



Heucherella 'Hot Buttered Rum'

- **Use:** Caramel-dipped, deeply-cut maple leaves adorn this aptly named plant from spring to summer. In fall, the cool weather burnishes the leaves to a lovely rose red - a perfect complement to fall-planted containers. Grows into a medium sized mound that's perfect in the landscape. Try it in a vertical planting with contrasting purple-leaved varieties of Heuchera. Great in a container or in the garden bed. Spills nicely over the edges of a container.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Fast growth to 7 "tall, 12" in bloom overall, by 12-18" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Warm coppery tones will warm your garden like a hot toddy on a cool day. Attractive, rounded maple leaf shaped foliage is glossy and appealing all season. Cool weather brings a lovely rose red transformation.
- **Flower:** White, bell-shaped blooms rise above height given: up to 12" in the summer.
