

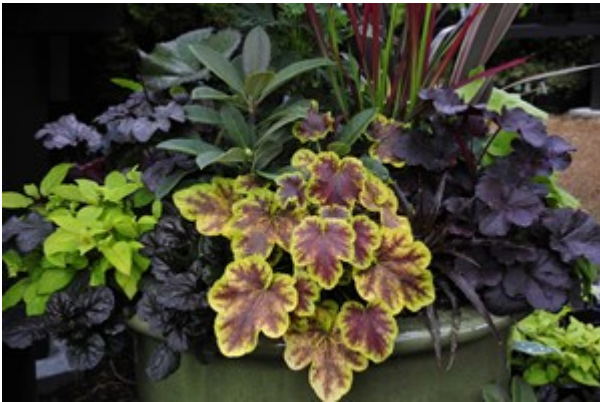
Solar Eclipse Premium Foamy Bells



Heucherella 'Solar Eclipse'

- **Use:** Don't miss this rare 'Eclipse'! Rounded mounds of chocolate-brown scalloped foliage appear as though they have been outlined with green glow-in-the-dark paint. Jaw-dropping for a dramatic look in part shade! Truly a breakthrough in Heucherella breeding, Solar Eclipse is out of this world! Captivating and vigorous dense mounds! An instant classic for containers and borders. A cross of Heuchera and Tiarella. Forms an expanding mound flowering in late spring into summer with strong.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- **Growth:** Fast growth to 10" tall, 16" in bloom overall, by 12" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen. Leaves of red brown bordered in lime green combined with such a beautiful habit and broadly scalloped leaf edges.
- **Flower:** Spikes of white flowers in spring-summer.

Because of their low, mounding habit, they are often used as edging along paths or in containers. Try cutting a few of the tall flower



scapes for fresh bouquets.
