Stoplight Premium Foamy Bells



Because of their low, mounding habit, they are often used as edging along paths or in containers. Try cutting a few of the tall flower scapes for fresh bouquets.



Heucherella 'Stoplight'

- <u>Use:</u> You'll stop in your tracks when you see the new H.
 'Stoplight'! Radiant yellow leaves have a large, dark red blotch in
 the center which feathers out through the veins. Stunning color
 for edging and mixed containers when combined with contrasting
 darker reds and blues.
- Exposure/Soil: Part sun-shade. Best when planted under other trees, but not too deep a shade or poor flowering and leaf color. Moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Water regularly, when top 3 in. of soil is dry.
- Growth: Fast growth to 6 "tall, 16" in bloom overall, by 12" wide.
- *Hardiness: 5*-8; Perennial
- Foliage: Semi-evergreen. Blinding yellow foliage with blood-red centers bring traffic in the garden to a standstill in spring. Summer foliage is pale yellow to green.
- Flower: Spikes of white flowers in spring-summer.
