This addition to the series offers the brightest burst of color on a petite plant. The large, pink flowers open slightly later than the other varieties in the series, extending the color into the fall season.

## *Hibiscus x x moscheutos* 'Head Over Heels Series'

- **Use:** This series displays exceptionally large flowers in a range of vivid colors.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Needs rich soils, consistent moisture and full sun. Also does well in clay soils. Good air circulation may help to prevent disease. Cut back stems to about 3-4" in Autumn.
- **Growth:** It has a plant height of 3-4' and a spread of 3-4'. Old stems should be pruned to the ground in spring.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4/5-9 Perennial. Mulch during winter to protect roots from frost and prune in early spring for bushier growth.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Large, lush foliage.
- **Flower:** The beautiful 6-8" begin to appear in late spring or early summer and continue into fall to provide a bounty of color and a taste of the tropics.
