

Summerific® Edge of Night Hardy Hibiscus



Hibiscus 'Summerific Edge of Night' PP34359

- **Use:** At only 3-3½' tall, one of the most compact Hibiscus to date. 7-8" bubblegum pink flowers have overlapping petals and darker pink veining for a dramatic 3D effect. Jet black foliage is the darkest we've seen on a Hibiscus and contrasts nicely with the green flower calyxes and red veining and petioles. Compared to 'Evening Rose', this has darker foliage, a more compact habit, and brighter pink flowers. Best color and performance will be in full sun.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Needs rich soils, consistent moisture and full sun. Also does well in clay soils. Good air circulation may help to prevent disease. Cut back stems to about 3-4" in Autumn.
- **Growth:** It has a plant height of 3-3.5' and 4-4.5' wide. Old stems should be pruned to the ground in spring.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9 Perennial. Mulch during winter to protect roots from frost and prune in early spring for bushier growth.
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Large, lush near black foliage.
- **Flower:** Large 7-8" bubblegum pink flowers have darker pink veining from summer until late fall.

These North American native plants bring massive, tropical-looking flowers all the way to zone 4. Although later to emerge than most perennials in spring, these are fast growing
