Hosta 'Albomarginata'

- **Use:** Hostas are exceedingly popular perennials in today's gardens due to their versatility in the landscape. Their subtle colors, tall flower scapes, and broad, coarse leaves fill a niche in garden designs that few other plants can achieve. Their large leaves provide excellent coverage for dying bulb foliage. Unequaled for their handsome, broad, ribbed, wavy foliage in many colors and their bell-shaped flowers. Ideal for perennializing, providing sparkling color for years and years.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Will grow 18" to tall and spreads up to 40" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Medium green leaves with wavy, white margins and gray-green streaks at the junction of the margin and center; may lose its variegation temporarily in containers during the hottest part of the season
- **Flower:** Pale lavender flowers appear on 31-45" scapes in midsummer
