

# Ann Kulpa Hosta



Sun or shade loving and very easy to grow! A fast growing large type!



**Hosta 'Ann Kulpa'** (breeder J. Kulpa, 1999)

- **Use:** What a combination ... White centers and Fast Growing! This mound-like hosta emerges with yellow centers which brighten to white as summer nears. Slightly rippled darker green margins offset the lighter centers. The striking variegation pattern of 'Ann Kulpa' lends itself for use as a specimen hosta. Sure to become a favorite!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Will grow 19” to tall(28” in bloom) and spreads up to 40” wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The large heart-shaped leaves have a clean white center, with a chartreuse overlay where the center and green margin overlap.
- **Flower:** Bell shape flowers are pale lavender in color and appear during mid Summer.
