Hosta 'August Moon'

- **Use:** Heavily textured, wide, heart-shaped, thick, slug resistant leaves that emerge chartreuse, turn a soft yellow as they age, and mature to a luminescent golden yellow. The dramatic, color-shifting foliage brightens shaded borders and woodland gardens. Produces large spikes of pale lavender flowers in summer.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Tolerates full sun which will intensify the gold color of the leaves. Part sun–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Quickly forms medium to large foliage clump 20 in. tall, 36 to 42 in. wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Medium-large yellow leafed hosta. Leaves are heart-shaped (often with pinched lobes).
- **Flower:** Bell-shaped, light lavender to white, flowers bloom in mid-summer on grayish-yellow scapes rising to 32" tall.
