

# Beyond Glory Hosta



**Hostas are exceedingly popular perennials in today's gardens due to their versatility in the landscape.**

**Their subtle colors, tall flower scapes, and broad, coarse leaves fill a niche in garden designs that few other plants can achieve. Their large leaves provide excellent coverage for dying bulb foliage. Hostas also grow well in city environments where the air may be polluted by car exhaust, etc.**

## ***Hosta 'Beyond Glory'***

- **Use:** Great for shady areas such as under trees or for areas with morning sun only. This new sport of H. 'Old Glory' adds a wider margin which makes the colors stand out better.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Slug resistant type.
- **Growth:** Grows 16 inches tall by 40 inches wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Thick gold leaves have very wide dark green margins. Leaves are slightly rippled which helps to show off this beauty.
- **Flower:** Nice lavender flowers shine above the foliage in midsummer.
