- <u>Use:</u> Great for shady areas such as under trees or for areas with morning sun only. 'Blue Angel' never fails to attract attention (like traffic-stopping attention!) Probably the largest all blue hosta.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun (best)—shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- <u>Growth</u>: 48 inches wide (or much more) x 36 inch height, slow to medium growth rate.
- Hardiness: Zone 5-8 Perennial
- Foliage: Deciduous.). It has huge, blue-grey leaves, and the three plants make a circle 4 feet across!.
- **Flower:** In the summer, this rich mound of foliage is topped and accented with spikes of large, pure white flowers.

Shade loving and 'very easy to grow!'
