Hosta 'Blue Hawaii'

- **Use:** Like it's tropical waters, 'Blue Hawaii' boasts a rich and powdery sky blue color. It's leaves have thick substance and are intensely glaucous on top and bottom. This tall Hosta reaches up, bringing the sky to the earth.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun (best)—shade. Can take full sun way up North, but down here in the South our hot August days would melt them in full sun. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Grows 42 inches wide (or much more) x 30 inch height, with a medium growth rate.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Its attractive textured heart-shaped, puckered leaves remain powder blue in color with hints of bluish-green throughout the season.
- **Flower:** In the summer, this rich mound of foliage is topped and accented with spikes of white tubular flowers.
