Hosta 'Blue Mouse Ears'

- **Use:** Hosta winner of the year for 2008! Great for shady areas such as under trees or for areas with morning sun only. This dwarf Hosta is most suitable in containers, rock gardens, or border plantings. Hated by slugs
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun (best)–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Mature height of 6-7" tall and wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Small round, heart shaped blue leaves. Extremely thick substance, with each leaf having a tiny white edge, more pronounced in early Spring, but evident throughout the entire season.
- **Flower:** In early summer, the clumps are topped with proportionally short spikes of lavender flowers.
