Hosta 'Christmas Pageant'

- <u>Use:</u> Hostas are exceedingly popular perennials in today's gardens due to their versatility in the landscape. Their subtle colors, tall flower scapes, and broad, coarse leaves fill a niche in garden designs that few other plants can achieve. Their large leaves provide excellent coverage for dying bulb foliage. Hostas also grow well in city environments where the air may be polluted by car exhaust, etc. Hosta Christmas Pageant has a very massive, green leaves and a distinctive, yellow-creamy in summer creamy white margin. It is a tetraploid cultivar derived from Christmas Tree. Very vigorous, richly blooming and has a particularly very solid leaves.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- Growth: Will grow 17 inches tall by 30 inches wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 4-8; Perennial
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous. Leaves are very dark green with margins that change from yellow to creamy white. Thick foliage holds its color well through the summer.
- Flower: Pale lavender flowers bloom on 20" scapes in mid summer.
