Hosta 'Drinking Gourd'

- **Use:** Great for shady areas such as under trees or for areas with morning sun only. From the hosta wild man, Chuck Purtymun, comes this still hard-to-find gem(H. 'Tokudama' x H. sieboldiana) In a garden, few hostas will evoke more favorable comments!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Will grow 15” to tall and spreads up to 36" wide. Vigorous grower.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. It has round, cardboard-like, deeply cupped, powder-blue leaves on a 2' wide clump.
- **Flower:** In early summer, the clumps are topped with white flowers.
