Hosta 'Fire & Ice'

- **Use:** A striking, reverse sport of the widely admired Patriot' (Hosta of the Year in 1997). The leaves of 'Fire and Ice' have a heavy substance and a slight twist that creates a sense of movement and draws your eye to their pure white centers and dark green edging. A midsize Hosta that's showy as a specimen or bedded out in groups. A must for the collector.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun (best)–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Grows 13" ht x 24" w
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Pure white leaves w/ dark green margins.
- **Flower:** In midsummer, lavender flowers appear on 20in scapes.
