Colorful Hosta foliage that is highly slug resistant due to thick leaves!

Hosta 'Fire Island' (small-medium type)

- **Use:** Gold Hostas make a shade garden glow and this one is a real conversation piece with red stems. In shade, leaves change to chartreuse through the season with red petioles. We think they look great in patio containers where they can really show off their foliage. Parent – longipes hypoglauca x CRESTED SURF.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun (best)–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Mature size about 16 inches high and 15 inches wide, mound-like with fast growth rate.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Brilliant yellow, intensely wavy, broadly ovate leaves and light red petioles with red coloration extending into leaf base.
- **Flower:** Lavender flowers in midsummer.
