## ***Hosta 'Great Expectations'***

- **Use:** What can we say that hasn't been said about the most beautiful hosta available today? This sport of *H. sieboldiana* 'Elegans' from England has a fabulous cream center (emerging gold in early spring), surrounded by a dramatic, wide blue-green edge...sure to brighten any garden. The medium-sized clump, to 30" wide, is topped with near-white flowers in early summer...once you see it you gotta have it! *H. 'Great Expectations'* needs morning sun or very open shade to grow properly..
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Will grow 20 inches height x 24 inches wide, mound-like.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Thick, round, golden leaves with wide dark blue margin. Thick leaves are slug resistant.
- **Flower:** The flowers are white and long lasting in summer.
