Hosta 'Guacamole'

- **Use:** Great for shady areas such as under trees or for areas with morning sun only. Probably the most exciting new hosta to hit the market in years. This is a reverse variegated sport of H. 'Fragrant Bouquet' This beauty was voted Hosta of the year in 2002! This is one of the few available hostas with flowers so intensely fragrant there's no need to seek out the scent; it finds you.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Will thrive unattended in dry shade once established.
- **Growth:** Vigorous growing clump, to 4' wide and 15" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The leaves are large, well-rounded and shiny chartreuse green with a pronounced blue edge.
- **Flower:** Giant-sized, near-white fragrant flowers in late summer.
