

Halcyon Hosta



A popular mid-sized, blue hosta; leaves are frosty blue-green and pointed
A superb grower with thick leaves that demonstrate good slug resistance

Hosta 'Halcyon'

- **Use:** Hostas are exceedingly popular perennials in today's gardens due to their versatility in the landscape. Their subtle colors, tall flower scapes, and broad, coarse leaves fill a niche in garden designs that few other plants can achieve. Their large leaves provide excellent coverage for dying bulb foliage. Hostas also grow well in city environments where the air may be polluted by car exhaust, etc.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Morning sun and afternoon shade (best)—full shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Growing 18" tall and 36" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. It has huge, blue-grey leaves.
- **Flower:** Pale blue-violet flowers appear on 28" scapes in mid-summer.
