## ***Hosta 'June'***

- **Use:** Great for shady areas such as under trees or for areas with morning sun only. From England comes this wildly popular, creamy-centered sport of the old standard H. 'Halcyon'. . This is one of those shockingly beautiful hostas that stand out as soon as you spot it in the garden. We recommend some morning sun for best coloration.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun (best)–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** The 3' wide clumps grow quickly to 18" tall.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Each leaf emerges with blue edges and a brilliant creamy center that gradually changes to dark chartreuse.
- **Flower:** Light violet flowers on 20" scapes in early summer.
