## ***Hosta 'Lakeside Paisley Print'***

- **Use:** Hostas are exceedingly popular perennials in today's gardens due to their versatility in the landscape. Their subtle colors, tall flower scapes, and broad, coarse leaves fill a niche in garden designs that few other plants can achieve. Their large leaves provide excellent coverage for dying bulb foliage. Hostas also grow well in city environments where the air may be polluted by car exhaust, etc. This striking small hosta is from the breeding program of Mary Chastain.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Forms a small, 10" tall x 20' wide clump. (24" tall in flower)
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Produces thick, heart-shaped leaves with very wide, wavy, green margins. The narrow, creamy white markings in the center of the leaves shoot out from the cream colored petioles in a feathery pattern.
- **Flower:** Cream scapes carry the light lavender flowers in midsummer.
