- <u>Use:</u> One of the very best small, yellow hostas. Hostas are exceedingly popular perennials in today's gardens due to their versatility in the landscape. Their subtle colors, tall flower scapes, and broad, coarse leaves fill a niche in garden designs that few other plants can achieve. Their large leaves provide excellent coverage for dying bulb foliage.
- Exposure/Soil: Part sun (best)–shade. Acid, moist, welldrained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- *Growth:* Mature height of 10" tall and 14" wide.
- t. <u>Hardiness</u>: Zone 3-8; Perennial
- Foliage: Deciduous. Bright gold, 5", rounded leaves are deeply cupped and corrugated. They are of heavy substance and demonstrate good slug resistance
- *Flower:* Near white flowers appear on 18" scapes in midsummer
