

Party Streamers Hosta



Hostas are exceedingly popular perennials in today's gardens due to their versatility in the landscape.

Their subtle colors, tall flower scapes, and broad, coarse leaves fill a niche in garden designs that few other plants can achieve. Their large leaves provide excellent coverage for dying bulb foliage. Hostas also grow well in city environments where the air may be polluted by car exhaust, etc.

Hosta 'Party Streamers'

- **Use:** This is definitely a hosta to celebrate! 'Party Streamers' has a habit that lives up to its name-long, narrow, wiggly yellow leaves form a mounding habit. Its rapid growth rate means you won't have to wait long to see it come to maturity. Deep purple flowers contrast beautifully with the foliage when they bloom in mid to late summer.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun (best)–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** The 12" tall and 30" wide clumps.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. These leaves certainly alert you to a party in the garden. This vigorous grower has long, narrow yellow leaves with lots of ripples.
- **Flower:** Deep purple flowers contrast beautifully with the yellow foliage in mid to late summer.
