## Hosta 'Paul's Glory'

- <u>Use:</u> As far as variegation goes, it is one of the kings! I feel that this is one of the top 10 Hostas! Make room for this one and put it in the center of your garden. Needs at least 3 hours of sun to bring out the fabulous gold center! Also excellent in containers.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun-shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- Growth: Will grow 15" to tall and spreads up to 36" wide.
   Hardiness: Zone 5-8 Perennial
- <u>Foliage</u>: Deciduous. Plant has blue-green margined leaves with center yellow, turning whitish. Mature leaves have a seersucker effect.
- <u>Flower</u>: Medium, bell-shaped, pale lavender blossoms in mid summer.
