## *Hosta 'Praying Hands'*

- **Use:** Hostas are exceedingly popular perennials in today's gardens due to their versatility in the landscape. Their subtle colors, tall flower scapes, and broad, coarse leaves fill a niche in garden designs that few other plants can achieve. Their large leaves provide excellent coverage for dying bulb foliage.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun (best)—shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Hostas are exceedingly popular perennials in today's gardens due to their versatility in the landscape. - **Growth:** Medium 14-18" (2' in bloom) - and 14-16" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-8; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Leaves have a matte finish above but are folded, revealing their shiny undersides. Dark green leaves are heavily rippled with very narrow, gold margins. Upright, narrow, tightly folded leaves resemble hands folded in prayer.
- **Flower:** Lavender flowers on 18" scapes are abundant in late summer.
