Hostas are exceedingly popular perennials in today's gardens due to their versatility in the landscape. Their subtle colors, tall flower scapes, and broad, coarse leaves fill a niche in garden designs that few other plants can achieve. Their large

leaves provide excellent coverage for dying bulb foliage. Hostas also grow well in city environments where the air may be polluted by car exhaust, etc.

Hosta hybrid 'Diamond Lake' PP30769

- **Use:** Use this large blue hosta to add color to your shade garden! Attractive, heart-shaped, thick and heavily corrugated blue leaves have wavy margins. The large size of this plant also translates to large leaves: they can get up to 9" wide by 11" long. Pale lavender flowers appear in early to midsummer. Use this blue hosta to add some color to your shade garden. This plays well with ferns, hellebores, and other hostas.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year. Clean away the dead foliage after frost to prevent insect problems.
- **Growth:** Vigorous growing clump, to 24-30" (in flower) high and 48-54" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Attractive, heart-shaped, thick and heavily corrugated blue leaves have wavy margins.
- **Flower:** Lavender flowers appear in midsummer.
