
## Shadowland Echo the Sun Hosta

- <u>Use:</u> This premium hosta variety is part of a group called Shadowland made up of the finest hostas available today. To be considered a premium hosta, plants must perform superbly in many zones. They must also exhibit exemplary garden presence and performance, have a long season of appeal in the landscape, have leaves of good substance, and demonstrate a greater resistance to common garden pests. The perfect choice for shade, hostas are exceedingly popular perennials in today's gardens due to their versatility in the landscape. - **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- Growth: Vigorous growing clump, to 18-27"(in flower) high and 42-48" wide.
- Hardiness: Zone 3-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous; A bright yellow hosta with pronounced rippled margins and the low, mounded habit is more prostrate than 'Diamond Lake', but shares a similar wedge-shaped leaf of thick substance. Thicker leaves mean more slug resistance.
- **Flower**: Lavender flowers appear in midsummer.
