
Etched Glass Shadowland Hosta



Hosta 'Shadowland' Etched Glass'

- <u>Use:</u> There are hostas, and then there's 'Etched Glass'-bringing style and refinement to your hosta garden. This sport of 'Stained Glass' has wider margins and thicker leaves than the parent. Very large and fragrant, near-white flowers appear in late summer. The perfect choice for shade, hostas are exceedingly popular perennials in today's gardens due to their versatility in the landscape. Their subtle colors, tall flower scapes, and broad, coarse leaves fill a niche in garden designs that few other plants can achieve. Their large leaves provide excellent coverage for dying bulb foliage. Hostas also grow well in city environments where the air may be polluted by car exhaust, etc.
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Part sun-shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- *Growth:* Vigorous growing clump, to 18-36" high and 36" wide.
- niche in garden designs Hardiness: Zone 3a-9b; Perennial
 - **Foliage:** Deciduous. Very wide, dark green margins contrast with a bright, brilliant yellow margin. Between the margin and the centers is a light green pattern. Margins have puckering when the plant is mature.
 - Flower: Near white flowers appear midseason.
