

# Sister Act Hosta



**Shade loving and very easy to grow! Good vigor and garden performance.**

## *Hosta 'Sister Act'*

- **Use:** This sport of 'Step Sister' has the same habit and performance as the parent but with very wide green margins. Good vigor and garden performance. Near white flowers in early to mid-summer. Hostas are exceedingly popular perennials in today's gardens due to their versatility in the landscape. Their subtle colors, tall flower scapes, and broad, coarse leaves fill a niche in garden designs that few other plants can achieve. Their large leaves provide excellent coverage for dying bulb foliage.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun(with excellent soil and watering) part sun (best)–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Vigorous growing clump, to 15-20" tall and 3-4' wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Very wide green margins surrounding a yellow leaf.
- **Flower:** Near white flowers in early to midsummer.
