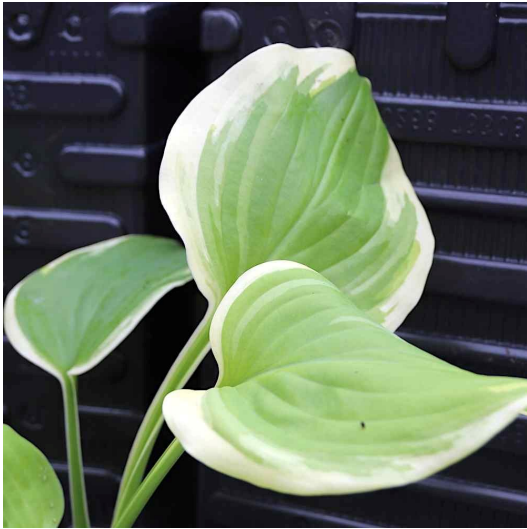

Hosta 'Sweet Innocence'

- **Use:** Glossy green leaves with wide white margins. An incredible growth rate and sun tolerance helped make 'So Sweet' the 1996 American Hosta Growers Hosta of the Year! This petite offering is excellent in containers on the patio.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun–shade (prefers at least afternoon shade). Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Will grow 12" tall and spreads up to 24" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 3a-8b Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Large, lime green leaves with a creamy -yellow edge that fades to creamy white later in the season. Fairly resistant to late summer burning.
- **Flower:** In late summer, the clumps are topped with 2' spikes of very fragrant, large lavender flowers.
