

# Tickle Me Pink Hosta

## ***Hosta 'Tickle Me Pink'***

- **Use:** 'One Man's Treasure' x 'Squash Casserole'; Leaves emerge bright yellow-chartreuse on red petioles with red tips and some red brushed across the shiny backs. As the season progresses, the leaves become a golden color with a slight sheen. Fuchsia-pink buds emerge in September on dark scapes and, as the cooler weather comes, the leaves are again kissed with touches of red
- **Exposure/Soil:** Part sun (best)–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** The 8" tall and 28" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. An impressive hosta boasting yellow-chartreuse leaves in spring each supported by red flushed petioles. As summer appears the leaves settle on a handsome golden-yellow tone which add a welcome complement to the reddish-purple flower scapes.
- **Flower:** Light violet flowers on 20" scapes in early summer.
