This hosta will catch your eye from quite a distance! Great for texture and contrast against other hostas. Shade loving and very easy to grow!

Hosta 'Wolverine'

- **Use:** Hostas are exceedingly popular perennials in today's gardens due to their versatility in the landscape. Their subtle colors, tall flower scapes, and broad, coarse leaves fill a niche in garden designs that few other plants can achieve. Their large leaves provide excellent coverage for dying bulb foliage. Hostas also grow well in city environments where the air may be polluted by car exhaust, etc.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun (with excellent soil and watering) part sun (best)–shade. Acid, moist, well-drained soil, but not soggy. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Vigorous growing clump, to 15-18" tall and 40" wide. Quickly forms a dense, mound with a cascading habit.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. The wavy, tapering leaves can measure 10" long. They are blue-green with wide, gold margins. In summer the leaves are green with a creamy white margin.
- **Flower:** Lavender flowers appear on 20" scapes in late summer
