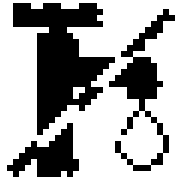


# St John's Wort



## *Hypericum frondosum* 'Sunburst'

- **Use:** Three-inch bright golden-yellow flowers burst open all summer long. Glossy blue-green foliage and a round-mounded habit make this an excellent border plant. Fall leaves turn yellow before falling off.
- Excellent for extreme slopes or sandy soils; spreads by underground stems; moderate drought tolerance.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-sun is best, although plants will adapt to partial shade. Too much irrigation or wet soils is not a good thing. A light trimming with the clippers in late winter (February) will encourage new growth in spring.
- **Growth:** Rapid growth to 12 inches tall and 18 inches wide.
- **Hardiness:** 6-10; Perennial groundcover
- **Foliage:** Evergreen; Emerges chartreuse-bronzed, but quickly turns to medium green then dark green, with fall color being a deep blue-green
- **Flowers:** Bright canary yellow flowers that contrast with the dark green foliage. Each flower lasts one to two weeks. Three-inch bright golden-yellow flowers burst open all summer long.

**Super fast groundcover for erosion control in difficult areas.**
