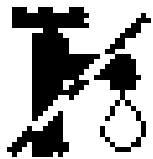


Miracle Horizon St John's Wort

- **Use:** Beautifully colored berries on perfectly formed plants, whether it's in the garden, as a lovely addition to any floral bouquet, or a brightly colored accent on your doorstep in the fall. This new line of St. John's wort gives you break-through, saturated colors that have never been seen before. It will fill your fall garden with interest and your floral arrangements and containers with large, shiny long-lasting fruits!
- **Exposure/Soil:** Full-sun is best, although plants will adapt to partial shade. Too much irrigation or wet soils is not a good thing. A light trimming with the clippers in late winter (February) will encourage new growth in spring.
- **Growth:** Rapid growth to 28-32" tall and 24-30" wide.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 6-9; Perennial / (shrubby growth)
- **Foliage:** Semi-evergreen/ deciduous; Incredibly rust resistant, deep, bluish-green foliage.
- **Flowers:** Enjoy bright yellow flowers during the Summer months and striking soft pink berries that attract birds and other wildlife in late-Summer through Fall.
