- <u>Use:</u> Beautifully colored berries on perfectly formed plants, whether it's in the garden, as a lovely addition to any floral bouquet, or a brightly colored accent on your doorstep in the fall. This new line of St. John's wort gives you break-through, saturated colors that have never been seen before. It will fill your fall garden with interest and your floral arrangements and containers with large, shiny long-lasting fruits!
- <u>Exposure/Soil</u>: Full-sun is best, although plants will adapt to partial shade. Tolerates deep shade. Doesn't like wet feet so don't overwater. May self-seed but not aggressively. A light trimming with the clippers in late winter (February) will encourage new growth in spring.
- Growth: Rapid growth to 30-32" tall and 28-30"wide.
- *Hardiness: Zone* 6-9; Perennial /(shrubby growth)
- <u>Foliage</u>: Semi-evergreen/ deciduous; Incredibly rust resistant, This variety has deep green foliage that blushes to red.
- **Flowers:** Bright golden-yellow flowers appear in summer followed by dark purple berries through the fall season. The berries are wonderful in fresh-cut flower arrangements. Attracts butterflies & birds.
