Iberis sempervirens 'Whistler White'

- **Use:** Tight, compact, spreading plants become covered with buds in late winter to early summer. These buds open to a cloud of small, white flowers that cover the plant into June. Attracts bees and butterflies! Deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Sun– part shade. Provide well-drained, moist soil, but not soggy. Use a slow release fertilizer. Superb in borders, beds, and open woodland gardens.
- **Growth:** Growing to about 4-8” tall and 8-10” wide, its relaxed mounding form is perfect for gently cascading over the border of a bed or tumbling out of a pot. Variety has improved vigor and branching.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-10, perennial
- **Foliage:** Herbaceous, evergreen perennial and a floriferous selection for borders, rock gardens or for use as a groundcover.
- Cutting grown.
- **Flower:** Large white-as-snow flower clusters cover this compact, trouble-free edger for a sunny site in late winter-early summer. A light shearing of top 10% of flowers will produce another surge of flowering often and keep plants bushy.
