Iris califlora 'Concertina'

- **Use:** Lush, rose-pink blooms are highlighted with soft blue beards and create a pastel palette in any garden. An intermediate iris, it grows to a modest height ideal for the front of sunny borders. Planted in drifts, this heirloom variety offers a pretty sea of pink. All parts of Iris are poisonous and deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial shade, in fertile well drained soil. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Grows 27" tall. Divide every 3-4 years. Space new container grown plants 18" - 36" apart.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Graceful, thick long blades.
- **Flower:** Rose self with blue beards and horns; reblooms. Early, midseason and late bloom and re-bloom. (Mid spring to early summer, reblooms late summer to early fall)
