Iris germanica 'October Splendor'

- **Use:** This gorgeous peach-pink iris will wow you with its enormous flowers, fancy ruffles and ethereal color. Tangerine beards make the blossoms seem to glow. October Splendor is also wonderfully fragrant and blooms twice per season: late spring and fall. An elegant addition to any perennial garden.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial shade, in fertile well drained soil. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Grows 24-30" tall. Divide every 3-4 years. Space new container grown plants 18" - 36" apart.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 4-9; Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Graceful, thick, long blades.
- **Flower:** Ruffled and laced pink self with tangerine beard. Has pronounced sweet fragrance. Provides consistent color, season to season.
