

Plesant Peasant Iris



Iris germanica 'Plesant Peasant'

- **Use:** Create a stunning display in your garden! Adapts to most soil types and tolerates drought well. Flowers are excellent for cutting. After the plant has finished flowering just remove the flower spike... don't cut the plant back to the ground. All parts of Iris are poisonous and deer resistant.
- **Exposure/Soil:** Plant in full sun to partial shade, in fertile well drained soil. Use slow release fertilizer two times a year.
- **Growth:** Grows 30-34" tall. Divide every 3-4 years. Space new container grown plants 18" - 36" apart.
- **Hardiness:** Zone 5-8 Perennial
- **Foliage:** Deciduous. Graceful, thick long blades.
- **Flower:** Luminous and frilly golden yellow petals are accented with tangerine beards and light mahogany veining. What's more, because this iris is a vigorous rebloomer, you'll enjoy lots of gorgeous flowers not once, but twice per year. They release a sweetly spicy fragrance. Early, midseason and late bloom and re-bloom. (Mid spring to early summer, reblooms late summer to early fall)
